INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR 2015/2016 ADMISSIONS

The College of African Wildlife Management (CAWM), Mweka is the leading institution in professional and technical training in wildlife and tourism management, conducting applied research and offering community services in the form of consultancies in wildlife and tourism management. The College was established in 1963 by the Act of Parliament Number 8 of 1964 and is registered by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) and recognized as a Centre of Excellence by the East African Community (EAC) and Southern African Development Community (SADC).

The Rector is hereby inviting applications from qualified Tanzanian and non-Tanzanian candidates for the following training programmes scheduled to start in August 2015 for Certificate, Diploma and Postgraduate Diploma Courses and October 2015 for Degree Courses:

1. Basic Certificate in Wildlife and Tourism Management (NTA 4)

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is an Ordinary Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least three (3) passes of which one should be Biology.

2. Technician Certificate in Tourism Hunting (NTA 5)

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Ordinary Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least two (2) credits and four (4) passes in any of the following subjects: Biology, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Agriculture, Nutrition, and English **OR** Certificate in Wildlife Management from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute **OR** Allied Basic Certificate accredited by NACTE **OR** Basic Certificate in Wildlife and Tourism Management from Mweka.

3. Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management (NTA 5)

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Ordinary Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least two (2) credits and four (4) passes in any of the following subjects: Biology, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Agriculture, Nutrition, and English **OR** Certificate in Wildlife Management from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute **OR** Allied Basic Certificate accredited by NACTE **OR** Basic Certificate in Wildlife and Tourism Management from Mweka.

4. Technician Certificate in Wildlife Tourism (NTA5)

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Ordinary Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least two (2) credits and four (4) passes in any of the following subjects: Biology, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Agriculture, Nutrition, English and History **OR** Certificate in Wildlife Management from Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute **OR** Allied Basic Certificate accredited by NACTE **OR** Basic Certificate in Wildlife and Tourism Management from Mweka.

5. Ordinary Diploma in Wildlife Management (NTA 6)

This is a two-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least two (2) principle passes and one (1) subsidiary in either Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Agriculture and Nutrition. **OR** Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management from Mweka or other recognized wildlife management training institutions.

6. Ordinary Diploma in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 6)

This is a two-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Level Secondary Certificate (or equivalent) with at least two (2) principle passes and one (1) subsidiary in either Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Agriculture, Nutrition, English and History. **OR** Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management from Mweka or other recognized wildlife management training institutions.

7. Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Management (NTA 8)

This is a 3-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** Form Six leavers (or equivalent) with at least two principle passes in science subjects: Biology, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Agriculture, Nutrition and Mathematics. Applicants must have a minimum aggregate point of 3.5 **OR** minimum Second Class Ordinary Diploma in Wildlife Management **OR** Wildlife Tourism **OR** related discipline from institutions recognized by NACTE.

8. Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 8)

This is a 3-year program. Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** Form Six leavers (or equivalent) with at least two principle passes in science subjects in the following: Biology, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Agriculture, Nutrition, Mathematics, English and History. Applicants must have a minimum aggregate point of 3.5 **OR** minimum Second Class Ordinary Diploma in Wildlife Management **OR** Wildlife Tourism **OR** related discipline from institutions recognized by NACTE.

9. Postgraduate Diploma in Tourism Planning and Management

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is an Undergraduate Degree in Wildlife Management, Tourism, Business Administration, Mass Communication, Biological Sciences, Law, Anthropology, Sociology, Community/Rural Development, Natural Resources Management and related fields from recognized higher learning institutions. A prior work experience in wildlife conservation, tourism, natural resources and environmental management sectors will be an added advantage.

10. Postgraduate Diploma in Wildlife Management

This is a one-year program. Minimum entry qualification is a recognized University undergraduate degree in Biological Sciences, Botany, Ecology, Environmental Science, Conservation Biology, Fisheries, Forest, Natural Resources and Management, Agriculture, and Veterinary Medicine. A prior work experience in wildlife conservation, natural resources and environmental management sectors will be an added advantage.

NOTE

Bachelor degree courses run from October to June for each academic year while all other courses run from August to June. All Form Six leavers shall apply for admission into Bachelor degree programmes to Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) through the Central Admission System (CAS) while Diploma holders and their equivalences shall apply for admission into similar programmes to National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) through the Central Admission System.
